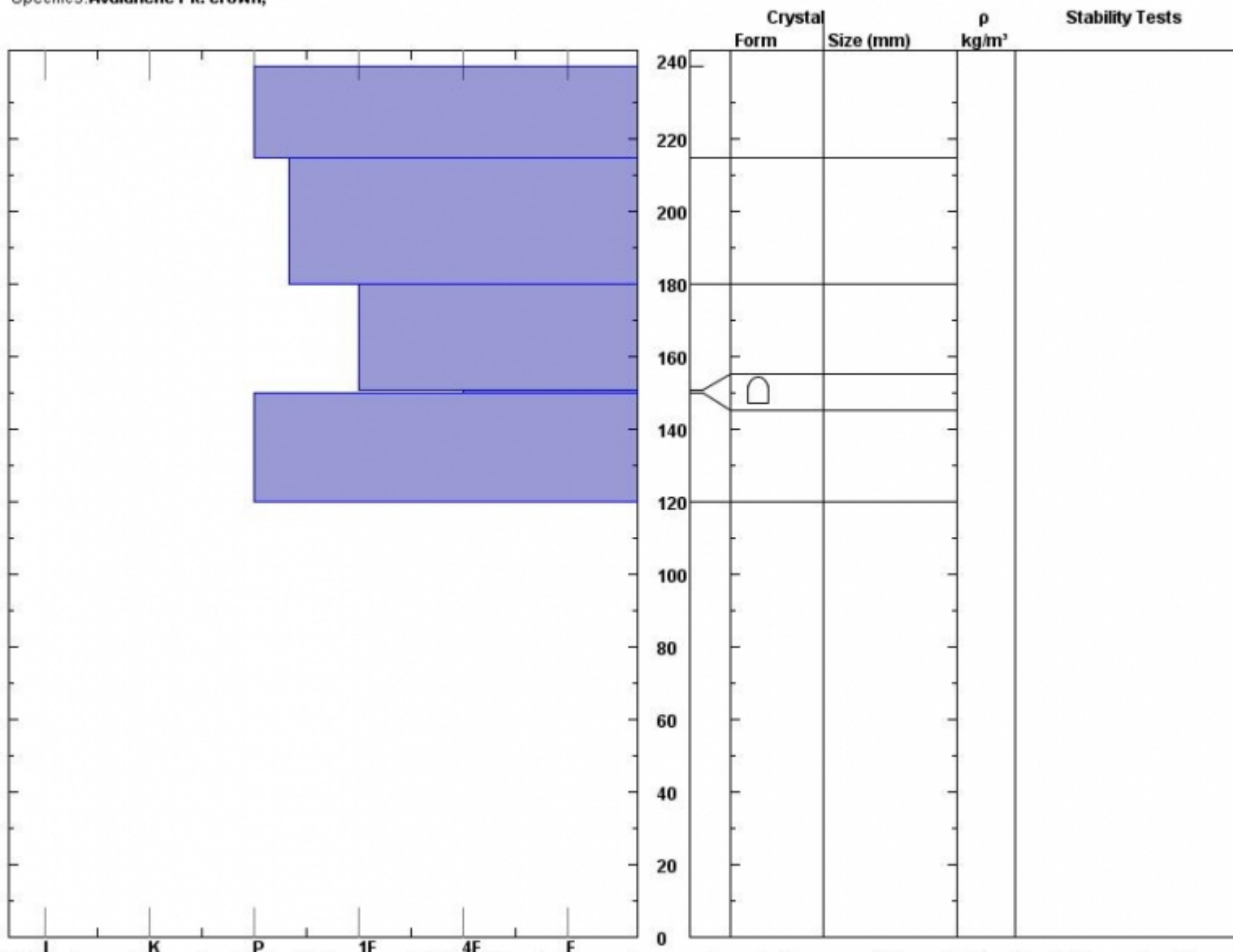

Notes: Crown from avalanche fatality. Crown varied from 100cm to 0 cm and snowpack varied from over 6ft deep to 3 ft on the Northern edge. It was li where the slab was thin and rested on weak facets. Very strong winds (40-60mph) occurred in this areas during recent days. it appears the vic partner traversed under this path very close to the crown before the second person triggering it on the descent.
